The Monterey Institute is pleased to offer scholarships for AmeriCorps alumni interested in professional, international careers. Scholarships are competitive and merit based.

For maximum consideration, students should submit the application for admission and all support materials, including transcripts, test scores, letters of recommendation resume and statement of purpose, by the priority deadlines. For Fall semester there are three rounds of scholarship selection: December 1, February 1, and March 15.

For Spring semester the priority deadline is October 1. Late applications will be considered for scholarships on a funds-available basis.

The Monterey Institute also matches Segal AmeriCorps Education Scholarships, up to \$4,725 for 2010-2011.
